#### **OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD PROJECTS:**

There will be a lunch served at 11:30 a.m. that morning before starting on the jump ropes, please join us for that as well. T-shirts will need to be cut up and more t-shirts are needed to continue making the jump ropes. If you have a scissors, cutting matt, or cutting tool, make sure to bring it along.

We will also be making pillowcase dresses. If anyone has fabric scraps, binding, elastic, lace, or ribbon that is 1.5 inches or less, it could be used for the dress project. See Mary Zeeb if you want more information or may have supplies that could be put to use with this project.

We're getting going early on the projects so that we have sufficient items to put in the Operation Christmas Child boxes. One of the next things we'll be working on is making a Christmas ornament for each box.

ITEMS NEEDED FOR OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD: The following items are needed for our goal of filling 300 Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes: Stocking caps and fuzzy socks are on sale now or soon (I purchased 288 pairs of knit gloves for 75 cents a 3 pack), watch for Valentine's stuffed animals or toys on sale after Valentine's Day, bars of soap, wash cloths, combs, brushes, hair scrunchies or ponytails.
