

Mark Hento Elliot Thomas **April Consistory Meeting Notes:** Chairman Henry Bender called the meeting to order and opened with prayer. Rev. Ryan VanderWees lead with devotions. The general fund treasure report was approved. To send Classis Minnkota \$1500.00 at this time for quota was approved.

Pastor Ryan VanderWees presented his March Pastor report. Discussion on confirmation and meeting with confirmands and their parents. Working on pulpit supply for June 16 and 23. Next Communion is May 19. Pastor Ryan received an email from LeRoy Christoffels, Classis Minnkota Clerk, of a special MinnKota Classis Meeting by Zoom on May 2.
