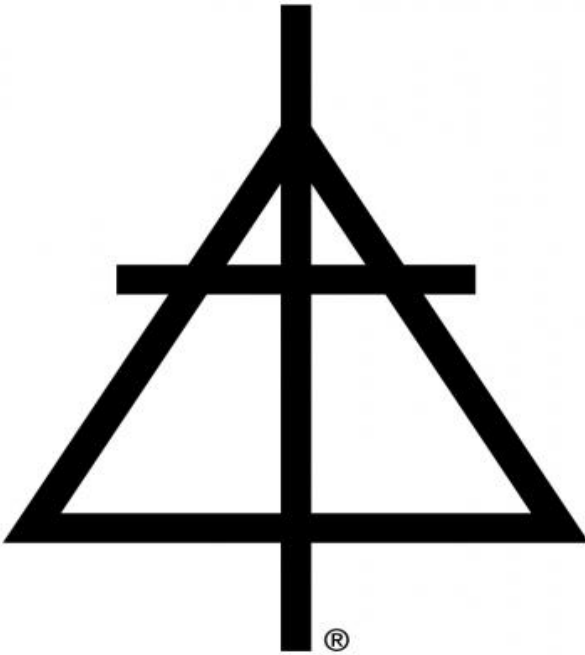

Sermon Outline:

1. Leprosy shows us our lost condition apart from Christ. (11-13)
2. The healing of the ten lepers shows us Christ's (and His Father's) willingness to be gracious and kind to us. (14)
3. The Samaritan leper shows us where grace and genuine faith leads us. (15-16 and 19)
4. The nine lepers show us the danger of a faith that falls short of love for Christ. (17-18)
5. Faith makes us well, and we live by faith, but faith must overcome many temptations and obstacles. (19)
