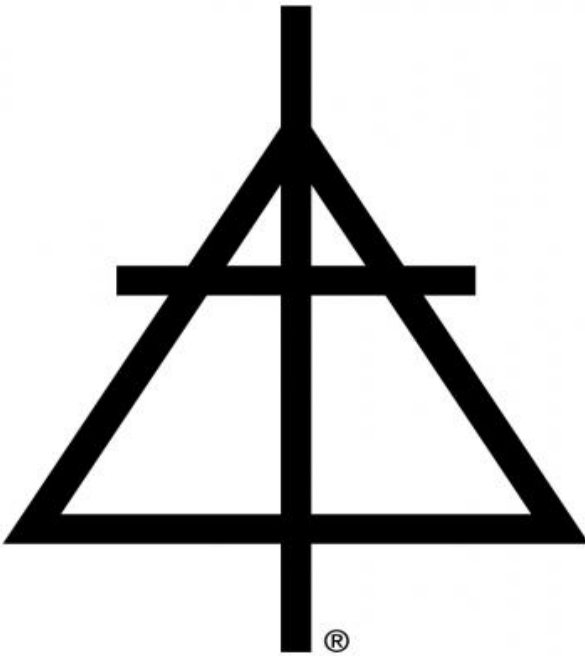

**Update from Jim & Christina Woehl:** Jim had a 6 week post radiation MRI on September 11. The tumor was essentially stable, which we are thankful for. He continues to take chemotherapy pills one week per month and has been tolerating these pretty well. He also has Parkinson's Disease, diagnosed about 18 months ago. He is currently struggling with his mobility, which they think is related to the Parkinson's more than the tumor. He is going to physical therapy three times a week now and is making progress. We continue to appreciate all the calls, visits, prayers, meals, gifts, and support of all kinds that is shown to us continually.

*How to pack a shoebox:*

(1) Shoebox: Get a standard-size shoebox to pack for a boy or girl. Preprinted shoeboxes are in the Social Hall at Peace Christian Reformed Church.

(2) WOW item: Select a quality “wow” toy such as a doll, soccer ball with pump, or stuffed animal to bless a child.

(3) Other Gifts: Pack full with other fun toys, hygiene items, and school supplies.

(4) Pray: Most importantly, pray for the child who will receive your gift. Include a personal note and photo to delight the heart of a child.

(5) Donate \$9 per box: A donation of \$9 per box is critical to cover shipping and other project costs. For easiest processing you can give online or give by check using the postage paid envelope. If you use our Follow Your Box feature online [samaritanspurse.org/occ](http://samaritanspurse.org/occ), you also discover the destination of your shoebox.

\*Opened with devotions. Minutes approved from September meeting, approved the general fund and building fund reports. Galen Guthmiller gave the treasurer's report with a balance of \$23,544.12.

\* Doug Schaeffer gave a report on the possibility of an STM becoming available. Motion made and passed to table asking Jack Grey to STM for the months of January to March 2021.

\*Ralph Schnabel reported on the Classis meeting.

\*Lord's Prayer: it was recommended to have the prayer after the congregational prayer.

\*Motion made and passed to give Dan Fergen \$300 for showing the sound committee how to use the sound system.

\*Motion made and passed to give Ben Myers and the Fabers each \$2000 for their ministries. \*Carpet cleaning was discussed.

\*It was discussed to have meetings with the congregation members and elders of the church. Motion made and passed to table to the next meeting.

\*Christmas program was approved. \* Communion was set for November 8.
